Notice

On February 5, 2004, at the Board of Directors meeting, the Board voted unanimously to increase the annual dues from \$100 to \$125 for the '04-05 renewals. This is due to several reasons. Property taxes have increased. Electricity costs have gone up. Liability insurance costs are up. We now will have insurance on the Hunter Education Building, a cost we have not had in the past and cannot afford to be without. Another reason to increase the dues was to save funds for maintenance of the rifle/pistol range baffles. They have been in place for approximately 12 years and are made of wood, which is showing signs of age. Replacement of these baffles will be a major expense.

\$125/year translates into \$10.42/month or \$0.35/ day to belong to one of the best Clubs in the Metroplex. While it is never popular to raise rates, it is necessary to cover basic costs. Remember, GPGC has no employees and relies on volunteers to do many things that are considered operational issues (i.e., tractor mowing, hauling off trash, loading targets, cleaning, maintenance, etc.). Your membership dues are a major part in supporting the general operations of our facility.
