# ATTENTION!

On Saturday, July 24th, someone used a target marker on the skeet field for a pattern board. Empty shell boxes were placed over the top of the PVC posts and then used for target practice. Not only does this damage the target marker (which requires someone's time and the shotgun committee's money to replace), but it violates the range rules. Use some **COMMON SENSE!** If you need to pattern a gun to see where it shoots, use the pattern board at the east end of the road past the last skeet field. Any future violations of this type will be subject to disciplinary actions of the Board of Directors!
