Shrimped doves

- 12 doves, whole and peeled
- Seasoning salt and peper
- 12 shrimp, peeled
- 1 large onion, sliced
- Margarine or butter

· Fresh mushrooms, sliced

• 1 large potato, sliced

• 8 slices bacon

Season each dove with seasoning salt and pepper. Insert one shrimp into each dove. Assemble doves by threes on a sheet of aluminum foil and suurround with slices of onion, potato, mushrooms and margarine. Place two slices of bacon over each three doves. Seal into foil packets. Place packets over hot coals on barbecue pit, close lid and cook for 20 to 30 minutes or until done. Serves four.
