Ranger Mountain. The lease was for bow only. We put up our feeders 3 months early and was pulling in some deer and some night feeding hogs and the deer left.

The second weekend morning this old wild boar with tusk worn to a nub showed up at my feeder 35 yards from my stand. My arrow hit at top and aft of the right shoulder and came out forward of the left ham. He run about 75 yards before he went down.

I shoot a Barnett Quad 300 crossbow with a 4X scope, 20" aluminum arrow with a 2" mechanical broad head at about 300 FPS.

Recipe Corner

Texas Perfect Hush Puppies

1-1/2 cups Cornmeal

1/2 cup Corn Flour (Masa Harina)

1/2 cup All Purpose Flour

1 tsp. Sugar

1 tsp. Salt

2 tsp. Baking Powder

1 tsp. Soda

1 tsp. Cayenne Pepper

1/2 tsp. Garlic Powder

1 Jalapeno Pepper, chopped fine

1 Large or 2 Medium Egg(s), beaten

1 cup Chopped Onions

4 or 5 Chopped Green Onions

1 cup Cut Whole Kernel Corn, drained

1 cup Buttermilk

2 Tbsp. Oil

Vegetable oil for frying

Sift dry ingredients together. Add chopped onions, green onions, jalapeno and corn to dry mixture.

Place 1 cup buttermilk in a 2 cup container, add egg(s) and 2 Tbsp. oil and beat until smooth. Stir in liquid ingredients to make a very heavy batter. Stir only until well mixed; do not overwork the batter.

If you have time, let the batter rest in refrigerator for 30-60 minutes. This will thicken the batter as the corn flour and wheat flours absorb moisture.

When ready to fry, heat a quantity of oil in a deep fryer.

Using small spring-release ice cream scoop, scoop a ping-pong ball size glob of batter into the hot oil. If needed, dip the ice cream scoop into water after each ball of batter is released into the oil. Brown well, the puppies should turn over by themselves, but you may need to give some of them a little help.

Drain on paper towels. Yield - about 3 dozen.

TRAVELING TROPHY GOES TO FIRST PLACE TEAM'S CLUB. (Winning club will host shoot next year).

RULES:

- 1. Shooters may shoot on one team only. (Exception shooters belonging to more than one club may shoot on a team from each club; 4 shooters need a 5th then one team member can be from another team or club). Team must consist of a minimum of 4 team members from the same club.
- 2. Each team shoots 50 skeet and 50 trap targets total of 100 targets per shooter. NSSA and ATA rules will apply. Club management will decide any protests.
- 3. For both team and individual, ties will be a shoot-off in the following format:

Teams and/or individuals will shoot 10 pair of skeet doubles from stations 3, 4, and 5. Teams and/or individuals will then shoot two shots of 16 yd trap from stations 1,2,3,4, and 5. If any team or individual is tied after shooting skeet doubles and 16 yd trap, shoot-offs will proceed to the 27 yd trap line and 2 shots will be shot at all five stations to determine a winner. Any ties will continue at the 27 yd trap line until a winner is determined. Order of shoot-offs will be teams followed by individual HOA.

- 4. No shell exceeding 3 dram, 1c, $7 \frac{1}{2}$ shot will be permitted.
- 5. Winning club will host inter-club challenge next year or has the option of passing the shoot to another club.
