Apple Honey Bar B Que Sauce With a Bite

1/2 cup butter

1/2 cup corn oil

2 medium onions, minced

2/3 cup Jack Daniel's

2/3 cup ketchup

1/2 cup apple juice

1/2 cup honey

1/2 cup dark molasses

2 tsp. Worcestershire sauce

1/2 tsp. black pepper

1/2 tsp. salt

Melt butter in a large saucepan, add oil. Cook several minutes over medium heat. Add onions and saute until golden. Add remaining ingredients and bring to a simmer, stirring frequently. Reduce heat to low and cook until thick--about 40 minutes.

Makes about 4 1/2 cups.
