Club Skeet Results

July 2, 2006



The day started with a hamburger lunch grilled to perfection by master chef, Benny Emmons. Randy Walhood filled in for Brad Fitzgerald (club shoot chairman), who was moving to a new home.

Twenty shooters participated in the .410 preliminary event consisting of 50 skeet targets. The winners are determined by Lewis class so everyone has a chance to win. There were four classes with Jim Cervenka winning Class I with a 49. Joe Miller won Class II with a 47. Doug Doyle won Class III with a 43 and Buz Owens won Class IV with a 41. All Class winners with the exception of Doug Doyle were won on the shoot off field against others who had the same score (so practice your doubles!).

Twenty four shooters shot the 12 gauge event. Joe Bettacchi returned to the competitive circle after a four year sabbatical and beat four other shooters (all with perfect 50's) on the shoot off field to claim the title of July Club Champ. Bobby Sherrill got AA1 and Gene Stewart got AA2. Jack Martin shot 49 to claim A1. Buz Owens shot a 47 to get past the other competitors for B1. Kent Megarity shot a perfect 50 which garnered C1 (last time in C class, Kent!). Jim Boyd collected D1 with a 44.

The Doubles Event is shot with no classes and is a 'heads up' competition. The competitors can shoot 'targets only' with no purse money or opt to play the purse. We had 18 shooters with 16 playing the \$20 purse. The money was split 3 ways in a 50/30/20% split. Jeff Zwiebel won 1st (\$160) with a 49. Benny Emmons won 2nd (\$96) with a 48. Bobby Sherrill won 3rd (\$64) also with a 48. Jack Martin also shot a 48 and beat Bobby Sherrill in the shoot off winning 3rd honors.....(but, he didn't play the purse).

Recipe Corner



Fire Cook's Steak & Eggs

- 6 Strip steaks, 1/2-inch thick
- 1 Lg. clove garlic, cut in half
- 1 tsp. salt
- 1 tsp. black pepper
- 1 tsp. ground red chili pepper or paprika
- 6 1-inch slices sourdough or country bread
- 1/3 cup bacon fat or butter
- 12 eggs

Rub both sides of steak with garlic; sprinkle with half of salt, pepper and chili pepper. Cook steaks on hot griddle, turning once, 2 to 3 minutes per side or until browned. Push steak to side of griddle to keep warm while cooking eggs.

Tear out the center of each bread slice, leaving 1/2 inch around edge. Reserve centers.

Heat bacon fat on the griddle. Place bread rings on the griddle. Break 2 eggs into each ring. Sprinkle with remaining salt, pepper and chili pepper. Cook 2 to 3 minutes. Place bread centers on griddle to toast.

Turn bread filled with eggs and toasted centers. Cook 1 to 3 minutes or until done. Serve eggs in toast along with breakfast steak.

Makes 6 servings.

Skillet Potatoes

- 1/4 cup bacon fat or vegetable oil, divided
- 4 cups thinly sliced raw potatoes (no need to peel)
- 1 med. onion, thinkly sliced
- 1 tsp. salt
- 1/8 tsp. cracked pepper
- 1/2 tsp. rubbed dried sage
- 1 tsp. dried parsley flakes, optional

Heat half the bacon fat in a heavy skillet over low to medium heat; add potatoes and onion. Sprinkle with half of the seasonings; cover pan and cook about 15 minutes.

Lift and turn potatoes, sprinkling with remaining seasonings. Cover and cook 15 minutes more or until done. Turn or stir potatoes once or twice during last 10 minutes so they cook evenly. Add bacon fat or oil as needed.

Makes 6 servings.


