# Recipe Corner Planked Trout

from The 50 Best

2 Small trout, boned Olive oil or bacon fat Cracked black pepper and cayenne pepper Salt Fresh herbs (rosemary, marjoram, thyme)

#### Directions:

Choose 2 thick non-resinous boards or a split log. Soak in cold water for at least 1 hour.

Build fire in front of a rock or sand pile to reflect heat towards fish. Let it burn down to hot coals. Pile coals in front of rock.

Center fish on boards, skin side down. Drive a few nails part way into each fillet to hold it in place. Brush with oil; sprinkle with black and cayenne peppers, salt and herbs. Cover ends of boards with foil to catch drippings and to keep boards clean. Stand planked fish at an angle in front of fire, tail end down. Rotate plank to ensure even cooking. Cook until fish flakes in thickest part, about 20 minutes.

Remove nails and serve on plank. Makes 2 servings.

Note: Planked trout may also be broiled on a grill. Place 6 to 7 inches from heat and cook 10 to 15 minutes or until fish flakes.

#### Equipment needed!

Grand Prairie Gun Club could use an old table saw, band saw, radial arm saw and a drill press if anyone needs to clean out the garage and would like to make a charitable donation. This would help with range repairs and making target frames!

# Pistol Range Improvements

The concrete work on the pistol range is complete and the range is open again. Target frames should be placed in the sleeves that have been installed in the sidewalks. Please use extra caution to make sure that your shots impact the bullet trap and do not ricochet off of the concrete or the ground. The baffle work will not be done until the weather warms back up.

#### 4th Annual Pheasant Tower Shoot

February 10, 2007

Gloomy overcast skies and near-freezing temperature Saturday, February 10th, was the beginning of another outstanding shoot for GPGC members. 20 gun club members with 10 friends and relatives loaded onto the trailer to the Tower and the sky opened up. Sunlight flooded the woods and the temperature rose. Within an hour the pheasants were falling and the coats had been shed.

360 pheasants were thrown with an 86% kill average. Each shooter came back with 7 cleaned and packaged young pheasants. New participants were surprised at how difficult the shots were. The leads were double what you thought they should be. A soaring pheasant can move about 60 mph with a few dips for interest.
