Recipe Corner

Chicken Fried Steak

from The 50 Best

2-1/2 to 3 lbs. round steak

1 5-ounce can evaporated milk

2 Tbsp. green Tabasco sauce

1/2 tsp. salt

2 cups all-purpose flour, divided

2 tsp. paprika

3/4 tsp. garlic powder

1 tsp. each, salt and cracked pepper

Vegetable oil

Directions:

Trim steak and pound, if needed, to 1/2 inch thick; cut into 6 to 8 pieces.

Combine milk, Tabasco sauce and salt in a bowl. Measure 1 cup of flour into a bowl. Combine remaining flour, paprika, garlic powder, salt and pepper in another bowl.

Dip steak into flour, into milk mixture, and then into seasoned flour. Set aside until all meat is coated.

Heat 1 to 2 inches of oil in a heavy fry pan. Fry meat until both sides are golden brown, about 2 minutes per side.

Drain on paper towels. Serve with Cream Gravy (see below), mashed potatoes and biscuits.

Makes 6 to 8 servings.

Cream Gravy

Pour off all but 6 Tbsp. of fat from fry pan; add 6 Tbsp. flour into pan (use any leftover seasoned flour) and blend well. Gradually stir in 2-1/2 cups milk. Cook and stir over medium heat until thickened. Season with salt and pepper. Cover steaks with gravy when served.

Makes 2 cups.



Keep the Ranges Clean!!!

For the last 4 or 5 years Benny Emmons has been bringing a group of his employees to the club twice a month to fill the houses, sweep out the buildings and empty trash. He does this at his own expense to help the volunteer members.

But the rifle and pistol ranges are getting out of hand with trash (see accompanying picture). The club has no paid employees and relies on shooting members and their guests to clean up after use. We need to expand the committees for each range and create a schedule to empty the trash (and haul it



off), weed eat and trim mow. Our tractor cannot get under the overheads or up close to do a clean job on the grass and weeds. Also we need a

volunteer group to regularly build new target frames and haul off old ones.

Please, when you use the ranges sweep up brass, throw away old targets and cardboard and carry off old shot up frames.

Do not bring old chairs and carpet from home. We generate enough trash without more being brought in.


