Trail Mix

- lbs. peanuts (dry roased, etc.)
- 8-1/2 oz. pkg. pretzel chips
- 7-oz. pkg. small twisted pretzels
- 5-3/4 oz. pkg. thin pretzel sticks
- 5.6 oz. pkg. corn nuts
- cup vegetable oil 1
- cup melted butter 1
- Tbsp. chili powder
- Tbsp. Worcestershire sauce
- drops green Tabasco sauce
- Tbsp. garlic salt 1
- Tbsp. seasoned salt 1
- tsp. ground cumin

Directions:

Mix nuts and pretzels in a large roasting pan.

Mix oil and melted butter, chili powder, Worcestershire sauce, Tabasco sauce, garlic salt, seasoned salt and cumin; pour over pretzels, mixing well.

Bake in a 250 degree over for 2 hours, stirring often.

Makes 5-1/2 quarts.

For variety, add chocolate covered raisins.



If you would like to improve your skeet shooting skills or if you would like to learn to shoot skeet, then you should know that Rick Stockstill is a Level 2 (National Skeet Shooting Association certified) skeet instructor. Rick does lessons by appointment and can work with shooters of all skill levels. Sessions usually run for about an hour. The first session also includes a check of gun fit, eye dominance, shooting stance, sight picture, a safety review and a review of shooting fundamentals.
