Recipe Corner

Venison Lasagna

from IHA at homestead.com

1 lb spicy venison sausage

2 tsp onion salt

2 tsp garlic salt

1 can 16 oz. whole tomatoes

1 can 15 oz. tomato sauce

3 tbsp dried parsley flakes

1 tsp sugar

1 tsp basil leaves

2 tsp salt

1 can 8 oz mushroom pieces

6 uncooked lasagna noodles

1 pk 16 oz pkg ricotta cheese

1/2 cup parmesan cheese

1 1/2 tsp oregano leaves

2 cups shredded mozzarella cheese

Cook and stir sausage, onion and garlic salt in 10-inch skillet until sausage is light brown. Drain. Add tomatoes (with liquid), tomato sauce, 2 tablespoons parsley, sugar, basil, 1/2 teaspoon salt and mushrooms. Heat to boil, stirring occasionally. Reduce heat. Simmer uncovered until mixture is consistency of thick spaghetti sauce, about 1 hour.

Cook noodles as directed on package. Reserve 1/2 cup of the sauce mixture. Mix ricotta cheese, 1/4 cup Parmesan, 1 tablespoon parsley, 1 1/2 teaspoons salt and oregano. Layer 1/2 each of the noodles, remaining sauce mixture, mozzarella cheese and ricotta cheese mixture in ungreased oblong pan, 10X6X2 inches.

Repeat above process until you have 2 layers.

Spoon reserve sauce on top, top with mozzarella and sprinkle with Parmesan.

Cook uncovered at 350F for 45 minutes. Let stand 15 minutes.

I must have been a good boy last year. Santa left me a 12 point or 13 point if you count the stub of the broken tine. Plus a couple of does.


They came from Sheffield, Texas

Future Construction

Future construction by the Trinity River Authority (TRA) will begin on our property in January 2008. This is to replace a large sanitary sewer line between the shotgun fields and the archery ranges. This is part of a large project that begins on our property and extends to SH360. The cost of this project is in excess of \$16 million and will be constructed by the S.J. Louis Construction Company. This project will not impact the rifle or pistol range. There will be times that the hours on the shotgun fields will be restricted. There will be advance notice of any change in operating hours after the contractor has had a preconstruction meeting. The archery range will be completely shut down for about the first year of construction. The large sewer line will run through the middle and entire length of the range. Aferwards the site will be graded and the range can then be rebuilt with permanent improvements. The sanitary sewer metering station behind our new building that provides that wonderful aroma will be relocated outside our main fence closer to Lower Tarrant Road. The new metering station will be sealed and access for TRA will be easier by being adjacent to the roadway. Stay tuned for more details!
