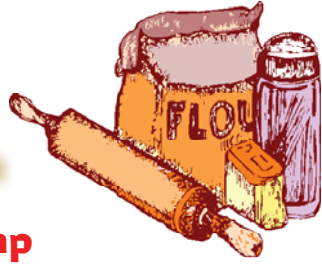

Recipe Corner



Cheese and Shrimp Creole

Butter or margarine, 2 tablespoons
Green pepper, chopped, 2 tablespoons
Onion, chopped, 1 tablespoon
Flour, 2 tablespoons
Salt, 1/2 teaspoon
Pepper, 1/8 teaspoon
Dry mustard, 1/2 teaspoon
Tomatoes, canned, 1 cup
Cheese, shredded, 1-1/2 cups
Egg beaten, 1
Milk, 1/4 cup
Shrimp, 1 package salad shrimp

Melt butter in skillet. Add green pepper and onion; brown lightly.

Blend in flour and seasonings. Slowly add tomatoes until thickened.

Add cheese. Stir in egg - stir constantly. Stir in milk. Add shrimp and heat thoroughly. Excellent served over rice.

Hot Peas

2 large cans black-eyed peas (Ranch Style is good)
or 3 regular sized cans
1 can Rotel diced tomatoes
1 cup chopped onion
1 cup chopped celery
1 cup chopped green bell pepper

Place the black-eyed peas in a saucepan. Sauté the onions, celery, and bell pepper in butter until tender. Add the can of Rotel tomatoes and sautéed vegetables to the black-eyed peas. Simmer until all ingredients are tender and heated thoroughly (about 30 minutes).

Note: You can adjust the sautéed vegetables according to taste.

that improve have the best chance of winning.***

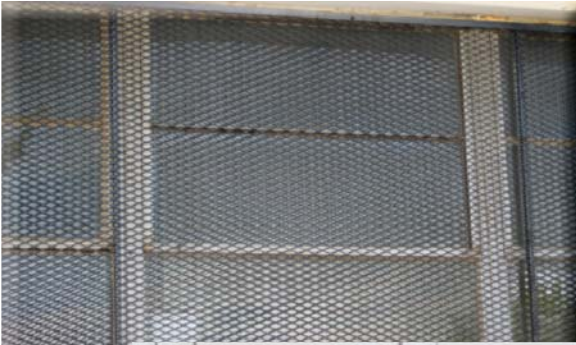
***Fees: \$100.00 per person and includes targets, prize fund and end
