

GPGC Bullseye Pistol November 2010

We took a vote and decided to shoot 2 regular bullseye matches for today for a 600 max score. It went as follows: we shot 2 slow fire, 2 timed fire and 2 rapid fire sets of targets. The weather was greatno rain, not too cool, it was just pleasant.

We had 13 shooters to compete. So as we have 12 lanes to shot in, 2 guys doubled up on lane 1. Jim Wilson chose to be the odd man and he called the match timing for the rest of us 12 and then after we had shot, I called for him to shoot.

In the first match, Hoa Nguyen won with 268-4Xs, Clint Freeman was 2nd with 263-6Xs and Jim Wilson was 3rd with 254-8Xs. Hoa shot a M 1911 conversion with a fixed barrel and a red dot scope. Jim Wilson shoots a Ruger Mk III with a \sim 7" barrel with iron sights.

In the 2nd match Ed Dotson was winner with a score of 280-9Xs shooting a M 1911 conversion (to .22 LR with a fixed barrel), that was scoped with a red dot scope.

I was second with Ruger Mk II Bull gun, 10" barrel model ,with iron sights, scoring 275-5Xs and Clint Freeman was 3rd with 272-5Xs, also with iron sights.

Clint was shooting a Ruger Mk II with a long barrel (I don't know if it is 8" or longer.)




