Recipe Corner



Potato Soup

Ingredients:

5 medium russet potatoes, peeled, washed, cubed

1 small onion, chopped

2 stems of celery, diced

1.5 tbsp. celery salt

1 tsp. seasoned salt

1 tbsp. dried basil, crushed

1 tbsp. dried parsley

1 tbsp. black pepper

2 chicken bouillon cubes dissolved in 5 cups water

2 tbsp. all-purpose flour

4 slices bacon, diced

1.5 cups milk

Method

Combine all ingredients EXCEPT bacon, flour and milk. Cover and begin a nice fast boil. Once the potatoes become "almost" done, use a masher to break down potatoes. Reduce heat to LOW and leave uncovered.

In a separate 12" skillet, fry bacon until just crisp. Remove to drain; leave grease in pan. Sift flour over grease and stir to combine. Once flour is combined, add in milk, stirring vigorously, turn to high heat. Once milk bubbles, add mixture to potato pot. Stir well. Continue to stir for about a minute; turn heat to medium. Cover pot and allow to simmer for about 10 minutes. Soup will thicken.

If you like your soup more chunky, don't mash the potatoes as much. Top with crispy bacon. Cheddar cheese, green onion, optional.

Veggie Bars

Ingredients:

2 - 8 oz. cans of crescent dinner rolls

2 - 8 oz. pkgs. cream cheese (softened)

1/4 cup mayonnaise

1 - 1 oz. pkg ranch style salad dressing mix

1 medium red pepper, chopped

1 medium green pepper, chopped

3/4 cup of shredded cheddar cheese

1/2 cup broccoli florets, chopped

1/2 cup mushrooms, chopped

Directions

Unseal the crescent rolls and place in a lightly greased 15"x10"x1" pan, pressing the edges together to cover the bottom of the pan. Bake 7 to 8 minutes at 350 degrees and then let cool.

Combine the cream cheese, mayonnaise, and salad dressing mix. Mix until smooth. Spread this mixture over cooled bread. Combine peppers, cheese, broccoli and mushrooms, and sprinkle over cream cheese mixture.

Cover and chill for about 8 hours. Cut into 1-1/2'' squares.

Yield: 8 dozen colorful, tasty servings.
