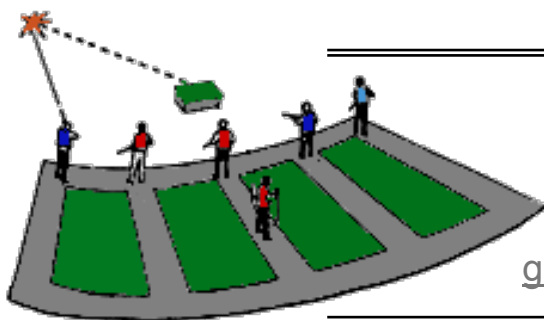
GINNY WARREN – TRAP LADY

GPGC Spring Skeet Leagues



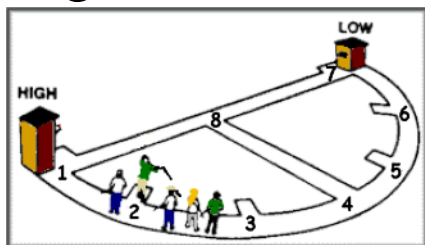

Monday evenings beginning March 21st and continuing for 6 weeks, from 5:30 pm till dark. The goal is to help new shooters learn basics and gain a comfort level with the sport. There is no charge for the shoot except the normal range fees. It is open to members, non-members, guests, and shooters of all ages.

Bring your shotgun, 2 boxes of ammo (best is # 8 or # 9 shot), earplugs, glasses and a shooting bag. Any gauge shotgun will work. We have several youth size 20 gauge semi-auto shotguns for use if you need one.

We teach shooting safety and stress enjoyment. Initially we try to work one on one with new shooters, then move them into groups of similar abilities and work with them as needed.

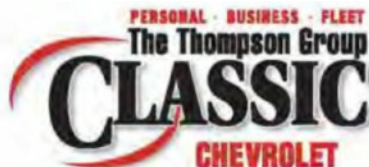
