TRA Repair Update




The TRA sewer line project work continues. Crews have been installing bypass lines in order to pump the flow around the damaged pipe. They are now ready to start replacing the main pipe

sections. To minimize the time that the pumps need to run, they will have two crews working non-stop during the week. They expect to average six

average six sections per day and have about 21 sections to replace.

All ranges will be closed all day during the week. The pipe sections are b e i n g




More Recognition and Awards


