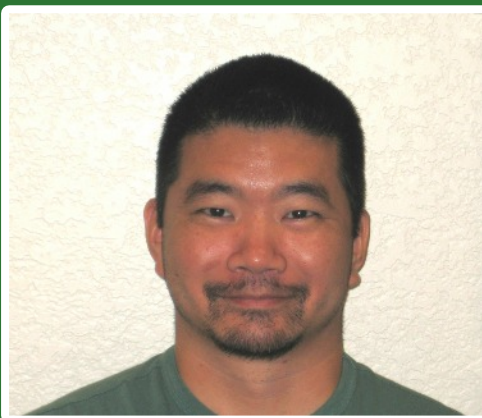

# TRA Repair Update



The TRA sewer line project work continues. Crews have been installing bypass lines in order to pump the flow around the damaged pipe. They are now ready to start replacing the main pipe sections. To minimize the time that the pumps need to run, they will have two crews working non-stop during the week. They expect to average six sections per day and have about 21 sections to replace.



All ranges will be closed all day during the week. The pipe sections are being

brought in from behind the rifle and pistol ranges. The pumps are also located there and must be frequently monitored/refueled. Vehicles and equipment will be moving around in front of the shotgun range all day.

The current plan is that they will continue not working on weekends, so all ranges should be open then as usual. However, they will still need to check the pumps every couple of hours. This will cause some temporary cease fires on all ranges, so please cooperate when these occur.

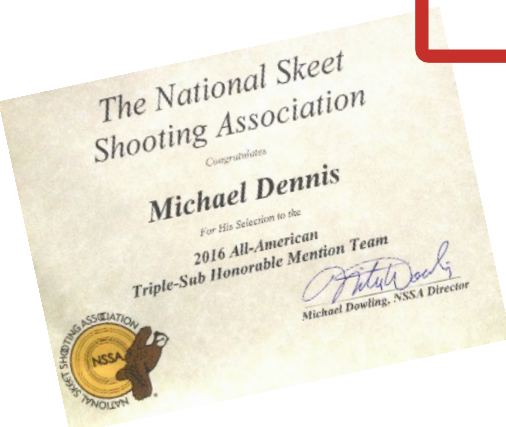

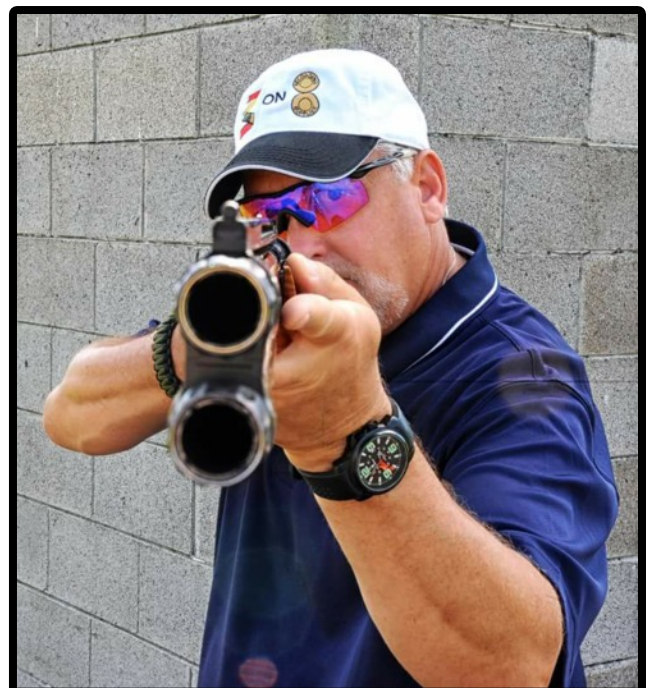


## More Recognition and Awards
