


TRA Repair Update

This public workshop will provide beginners and seasoned hunters alike with the knowledge, skills, laws, safety, and responsibility/ethics pertaining to hunting dove in Texas.

Topics covered during this training will include, but are not limited to:

Dove Biology (TX species, geographic locations, habitat, breeding & behaviors, aging, and mortality rates)

Game Laws (Harvest, tagging, shooting hours, counties, etc.)

Hunting Techniques & Methods (Ethical Shots/Shot Placement, gear, landowners/guides considerations, etc.)

Safety ("Zones of Fire", swinging on game)

Marksmanship Techniques (Patterning, judging distances, lethality)

Field to Table (Field dressing/cleaning, freezing, cooking).

Bring your own shotgun. No ammunition, please. Ammunition will be provided. The afternoon will include shooting and training conducted outdoors, therefore exposing you to adverse conditions. Please dress appropriately, and prepare yourself accordingly.

Cost: \$15 includes lunch, ammunition and clay targets. There is no cost to fully certified, active hunter education instructors.

The shooters were: Floyd Jester, Gary Ledbetter, Jim Wilson, and Jim Grabbe, I was behind the camera for this picture




