VETERAN'S CORNER







Russ Flippin entered the Navy in September 1987, following recruit training and Aviation Machinist training he was assigned to Helicopter Mine Countermeasures Squadron Fourteen (HM-14) flying in the MH-53E Sea Dragon Helicopter.

In 1991 HM-14 embarked on the USS Tripoli for Operation Desert Storm, sweeping mines in the Persian Gulf.

In 1992 Russ joined VP-49, an Anti-Submarine squadron, as a Flight Engineer flying in P-3 Orion's and was deployed to Iceland.

In 1993 he was assigned to VQ-1 Squadron flying out of Guam and Whidbey Island, WA. VQ-1 was an Airborne Reconnaissance squadron, deployed everywhere from Middle East to Japan.


There is a weekly trap shoot held on Thursday mornings at 10:30. It is very informal, for more information contact Jay or Ginny Warren. See scores from last week below.
