Interclub Challenge March 12, 2017


The Interclub Challenge had four teams, two from GPGC, one from Fort Worth and one from Ellis County.





GPGC Silhouette Match 03/25/2017



GPGC Bullseye Match 03/23/2017



Wow, Congratulations Gil!!


